9 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 A Joint Resolution relating to workers' compensation;
11 approving certain fee schedule; directing
12 distribution; providing an effective date; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 SUBJECT: Workers' compensation

15 WHEREAS, paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A
16 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the Workers' Compensation
17 Commission to evaluate the Fee Schedule for maximum rates paid for
18 reimbursement to medical providers and adopt updates or adjustments;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A
21 of the Oklahoma Statutes also requires the Workers' Compensation
22 Commission to submit the updated and adjusted Fee Schedule to the
23 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the Speaker of
24 the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the Governor; and

1 WHEREAS, paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A
2 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires approval by the Legislature of the
3 proposed Fee Schedule before the Fee Schedule can become effective;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, if approved by the Legislature, the proposed Fee
6 Schedule becomes effective on July 1 following the legislative
7 session in which the Fee Schedule received legislative approval.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
9 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

10 SECTION 1. The proposed Fee Schedule for maximum rates paid for
11 reimbursement to medical providers, as amended and updated pursuant
12 to paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes, and submitted to the President Pro Tempore of the
14 Oklahoma State Senate, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
15 Representatives, and the Governor, is hereby approved as required by
16 paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes.

18 SECTION 2. Copies of this joint resolution shall be dispatched
19 to the members of the Workers' Compensation Commission, the
20 Governor, and the Secretary of State.

21 SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective July 1, 2026.

22 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

2 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
