10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health
12 and Substance Abuse Services; requiring that portions
13 of certain appropriated funds be used for certain
14 purposes; authorizing request for early transfers of
15 certain funds for specific purpose; providing an
16 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
19 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill
20 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the
21 sum of Ten Million Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Eight
22 Dollars (\$10,812,408.00) shall be used for program growth and to
23 replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal
24 matching dollars.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
2 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill
3 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the
4 sum of Nine Million Four Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Hundred
5 Twenty-one Dollars (\$9,480,421.00) shall be used to meet the
6 obligations required in the consent decree pursuant to case number
7 23-cv-81-GKF-JFJ filed in the United States District Court for the
8 Northern District of Oklahoma.

9 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
10 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill
11 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the
12 sum of Eighteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
13 (\$18,500,000.00) shall be used for the continuum of care for
14 children in crisis.

15 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
16 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill
17 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the
18 sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00)
19 shall be used to maintain services for veterans and their families.

20 SECTION 5. The Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance
21 Abuse Services may request through the Director of the Office of
22 Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue

1 Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's
2 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

3 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

4 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
