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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the State Department
20	of Health in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the
21	60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand
22	Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used to maintain sickle cell
23	outreach.
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SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the State Department of Health in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be used for the operations of the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Act.

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SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the State Department of Health in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be disbursed to health centers authorized under Section 330 of the Public Health Service Act, and incorporated in the State of Oklahoma. Any disbursement shall be for the purpose of increasing access to primary health care which may include medical, dental, and/or mental health and substance abuse treatment services in or near designated Medically Underserved Areas or Medically Underserved Populations. Any disbursement for increased access to primary health care services shall be supported by data according to proportions of patient volume and access for the The method of disbursement shall be developed by the State Department of Health. The State Commissioner of Health is authorized to promulgate the method of disbursement into rules.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
