10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
11 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; requiring that  
12 portions of certain appropriated funds be used for  
13 certain purposes; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
17 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill  
18 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the  
19 sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be used for the  
20 Oklahoma State University Robert M. Kerr Food and Agricultural  
21 Products Center for operational expenses.

22 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
23 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill  
24 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the  
sum of Five Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,200,000.00)

1 shall be used for the extension offices that are affiliated with the  
2 Oklahoma State University Cooperative Extension Service.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
4 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill  
5 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the  
6 sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00)  
7 shall be used for research centers that are affiliated with Oklahoma  
8 State University Agriculture Experiment Stations.

9 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
10 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill  
11 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the  
12 sum of Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000.00)  
13 shall be used for cooperative extension and agriculture research  
14 programs that are affiliated with Langston University.

15 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

16 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
