16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1911 of Title 25, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. The State of Oklahoma hereby adopts the non-legally binding
21	Working Definition of Anti-Semitism adopted by the International
22	Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) on May 26, 2016, including the
23	contemporary examples of anti-Semitism set forth therein,
24	exclusively as a tool and guide for training, education, and

1 recognizing and combating anti-Semitic hate crimes or discrimination 2 and for tracking and reporting anti-Semitic incidents in this state. 3 The provisions of this act shall not be construed to Β. 4 diminish or infringe upon any right protected under the First 5 Amendment to the United States Constitution or the Oklahoma 6 Constitution. 7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. 8 SECTION 3.
