7 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to local law enforcement; creating  
9 the Public Safety Technology Revolving Fund;  
10 establishing revolving fund characteristics; deeming  
11 funds appropriated; providing purpose for  
12 expenditures; providing codification; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20m of Title 74, unless there is  
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 SECTION 2. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a  
19 revolving fund for the Office of the Attorney General to be  
20 designated the "Public Safety Technology Revolving Fund". The fund  
21 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
22 and shall consist of all monies received by the Office of the  
23 Attorney General as designated by law. All monies accruing to the  
24 credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and

1 expended by the Office for the purpose of funding grants to local  
2 law enforcement divisions to cover some of the costs associated with  
3 using technology to better interface with the public. Expenditures  
4 from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State  
5 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the  
6 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
7 approval and payment.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
