8 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

9 An Act relating to medication; defining term;
10 directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to
11 partner with the University of Oklahoma Health and
12 Sciences Center to provide medication to certain
13 inmates; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority
14 to directly pay the University of Oklahoma Health and
15 Sciences Center for medication for certain inmates;
16 providing for promulgation of rules; providing for
17 codification; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7500 of Title 63, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. As used in this section, "medication" means prescription and
23 over-the-counter drugs.

24 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall partner with the
University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center to provide
medication to detainees and inmates under the jurisdiction of a

1 municipality or county, and not under the jurisdiction of the
2 Department of Corrections.

3 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall directly pay to the
4 University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for medication
5 provided to detainees and inmates under the jurisdiction of a
6 municipality or county, not under the jurisdiction of the Department
7 of Corrections.

8 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules to
9 implement this section of law.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
