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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
19	There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement
20	Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 30.6 of Title 74 of the
21	Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
22	the Opioid Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury,
23	the sum of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) to be budgeted
24	and expended in accordance with law.

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1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be 2 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 3 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement 4 Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 30.6 of Title 74 of the 5 Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from 6 the Opioid Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury, 7 the sum of One Million Two Hundred Fifty-three Thousand Six Hundred 8 Fifty-eight Dollars (\$1,253,658.00) to be distributed to non-9 litigating subdivisions. 10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. 11 SECTION 4.
