8 POLICY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

9 An Act relating to milk; amending 2 O.S. 2021,
10 Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and
11 Milk Products Acts; providing additional acts that
12 are not prohibited; removing gallon limit for
13 incidental sale of raw milk; providing certain
14 protection from liability; and providing an effective
15 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk
20 Products Act shall not be construed to:

21 1. Include ~~incidental~~ sales of raw, unpasteurized cow milk,
22 goat milk, sheep milk, donkey milk, and horse milk directly to
23 consumers at:

24 a. the farm where the milk is produced,

b. feed stores,

- c. restaurants, for off-premise consumption only,
- d. at a farmer's market, or
- e. via delivery from the farm where the milk is produced;

2. ~~Preclude~~ Prohibit the advertising of the ~~incidental~~ sale of raw, unpasteurized cow milk, goat milk, sheep milk, donkey milk, and horse milk; and or

3. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

~~B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold does not exceed one hundred (100)~~ Any producer or seller of raw, unpasteurized milk, sold pursuant to this section, shall not be liable for any incidental illness due to the consumption of raw, unpasteurized milk by a consumer.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
