POLICY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

An Act relating to veterans; imposing requirements on executive governmental entities to provide information related to certain donations; providing for apportionment or deposit of amounts donated; requiring government websites to provide information related to certain donations; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7201 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each state agency, board, commission, department, or other entity organized within the executive department shall include on any of its forms as described by subsection B of this section a link to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs or similar method in order to allow a person making payment to such governmental entity

1 to make a donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
2 Revolving Fund.

3 B. The provisions of this section shall include, but shall not
4 be limited to:

5 1. Driver license applications;

6 2. Motor vehicle registrations and renewals;

7 3. Fishing and hunting license applications;

8 4. Income tax forms; and

9 5. Any other transaction during which an executive agency
10 issues a license or utilizes a form that could contain the
11 information prescribed by subsection A of this section.

12 C. If payment for any item or service described in this section
13 can be made through a website owned or maintained on behalf of the
14 governmental entity, the website shall have a conspicuous area which
15 clearly indicates that the payor may utilize the website to make a
16 donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs Revolving
17 Fund.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
