7 POLICY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making  
9 certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; providing  
10 forfeiture actions for seized property; providing for  
11 codification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1796 of Title 21, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any alien or person who is not a citizen of the United States  
18 who has unlawfully acquired title to or owns land in this state  
19 either directly or indirectly through a business entity, trust, or  
20 foreign government enterprise, and who uses such land to commit a  
21 felony offense in violation of state law shall, upon conviction, be  
22 guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the  
23 Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed five (5) years,  
24 or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by

1 both such fine and imprisonment. In addition, all property seized  
2 pursuant to this section shall be subject to the forfeiture  
3 provisions provided for in Section 1738 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma  
4 Statutes.

5 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
