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8 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

9 An Act relating to sexual assault nurse examiners;
10 amending Section 2, Chapter 343, O.S.L. 2023 (19 O.S.
11 Supp. 2025, Section 215.41), which relates to sexual
12 assault nurse examiners; deleting sunset date; making
13 an appropriation; requiring appropriated funds be
14 utilized for certain purposes; providing for
15 noncodification; providing an effective date; and
16 declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 343, O.S.L.
19 2023 (19 O.S. Supp. 2025, Section 215.41), is amended to read as
20 follows:

21 Section 215.41. Subject to availability of funding, there is
22 established ~~until October 1, 2025,~~ within the District Attorneys
23 Council under the direction of the Executive Coordinator of the
24 District Attorneys Council, the position of Sexual Assault Nurse
25 Examiner (SANE) Statewide Coordinator. The Statewide Coordinator
26 shall oversee forensic medical examination training throughout the

1 state, recruit and develop SANE professionals, create and expand
2 local Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner programs and Sexual Assault
3 Response Team programs throughout this state, and coordinate
4 payments from the Sexual Assault Examination Fund.

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
6 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

7 There is hereby appropriated to the District Attorneys Council
8 from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027,
10 the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of hiring a Sexual
12 Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Statewide Coordinator and related
13 program expenditures pursuant to the provisions of Section 215.41 of
14 Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

16 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
