Protection Agency carcinogenicity classification for the pesticide
under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, shall
be sufficient to satisfy any requirements for a warning regarding
health or safety under Oklahoma state law, including, without
limitation, the duty to warn, or any other common law duty to warn
if:

- 1. Approved by the Environmental Protection Agency under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry at the time of sale;
- 2. Consistent with the most recent human health assessment performed by Environmental Protection Agency under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act at the time of sale; or
- 3. Consistent with the Environmental Protection Agency carcinogenicity classification for the pesticide under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act at the time of sale.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
