| 15 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101.25, as |
| 16 | amended by Section 1, Chapter 5, O.S.L. 2024 (70 O.S. Supp. 2024, |
| 17 | Section 6-101.25), is amended to read as follows: |
| 18 | Section 6-101.25. A. Whenever a superintendent decides to |
| 19 | recommend that a teacher or administrator employed within the school |
| 20 | district be dismissed or not reemployed, the superintendent shall |
| 21 | state the recommendation in writing, setting forth the basis for the |
| 22 | recommendation, and shall submit such recommendation to the board of |
| 23 | education. |

If the teacher subject to such recommendation is a career
 teacher, the recommendation shall specify the statutory grounds for
 which the recommendation is based.

If the teacher subject to such recommendation is a probationary teacher, the recommendation shall specify the cause for which the recommendation is based.

7 The superintendent shall also specify the underlying facts8 supporting the recommendation.

9 Β. 1. If the recommendation includes grounds that could form the basis of criminal charges sufficient to result in the denial or 10 revocation of a certificate for a reason set forth in subparagraph a 11 12 of paragraph 6 of subsection A of Section 3-104 of this title, or if the recommendation includes a reason set forth in subparagraph a of 13 paragraph 6 of subsection A of Section 3-104 of this title and is 14 based on an agreement between the teacher or administrator and 15 school district to avoid civil litigation or a settlement of a civil 16 action unless the court orders the terms of such settlement to be 17 kept confidential, a copy of the recommendation shall also be 18 forwarded to the State Board of Education after the completion of 19 when the recommendation is made pursuant to the due process 20 procedures pursuant to provided for in Section 6-101.26 of this 21 title or after the teacher resigns, regardless of whether the 22 teacher or administrator resigns before or after a termination 23 recommendation is made, provided that the resignation occurs while 24

1 the teacher or administrator is under investigation for conduct that 2 could form the basis for criminal charges or certificate revocation. A report of such resignation including any investigatory findings to 3 date shall be forwarded to the State Board of Education. Failure to 4 5 forward a copy of the recommendation to the State Board of Education shall not be the basis for any claim or action against a public 6 school, its board of education, employees, agents, or other 7 representatives. If the school district forwards a copy of the 8 9 recommendation to the State Board of Education, the school district 10 shall contemporaneously forward a copy to the teacher or administrator subject to such recommendation. The teacher or 11 12 administrator may provide supplementary information to the State Board of Education. 13

14 <u>2. If the investigation into the conduct of the teacher or</u> 15 <u>administrator concludes without findings to support criminal</u> 16 <u>charges, certificate revocation, or termination, the individual's</u> 17 <u>report shall be expunged from State Board of Education records and</u> 18 <u>written notification of the clearance shall be sent to all affected</u> 19 <u>parties. Expungement may only occur upon sufficient evidence of no</u> 20 wrongdoing.

C. Only school districts may request a copy of the
recommendation from the State Board of Education, and only if a
teacher <u>or administrator</u> is being considered for new employment or a
teacher <u>or administrator</u> is currently employed by the requesting

1 school district. The State Board of Education shall notify the 2 teacher or administrator subject to the recommendation if such a request is made and provide the identity of the school district that 3 4 made such request. The teacher or administrator subject to the 5 recommendation shall retain the right to provide supplementary 6 information to the State Board of Education to accompany any documents requested. The State Board of Education shall provide the 7 requesting school district documents related to the recommendation 8 9 as well as any supplementary information provided by the teacher or 10 administrator subject to the recommendation, and copies shall be contemporaneously forwarded to the teacher or administrator subject 11 12 to the recommendation. Records provided to a requesting school 13 district pursuant to this subsection shall be kept confidential.

D. Except as provided for in subsection C of this section, the
State Board of Education shall keep recommendations submitted
pursuant to subsection B of this section confidential. Records
created pursuant to this section shall not be subject to disclosure
under the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

E. If the State Board of Education or a school district that generated or received documents pursuant to subsection C of this section is served a subpoena requesting disclosure of the documents, the teacher <u>or administrator</u> subject to the recommendation shall immediately be notified and be provided the opportunity to object to the subpoena.
