COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to medical marijuana; requiring display of certain signage in licensed medical marijuana dispensary; providing certain contents and requirements for certain signage; requiring licensee to pay cost of signage; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.18a of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Every licensed medical marijuana dispensary shall post and display at all times a printed sign with the minimum height of eight and one-half (8 1/2) inches and a minimum width of eleven (11) inches, with at least a 48-point font for the text, near the cash register or place of checkout and at least two other highly visible

1 places in the medical marijuana dispensary. The sign shall read as
2 follows:

3 "WARNING: INGESTING THC PRODUCTS WHILE PREGNANT IS NOT HEALTHY
4 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN UNBORN CHILD."

5 B. The signage shall be produced at the expense of the medical
6 marijuana dispensary licensee.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
