6	An Act relating to medical marijuana; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.10, as amended by Section 12,
7	Chapter 251, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 427.10), which relates to physician recommendations;
8	updating statutory language; requiring creation and maintenance of certain registry; providing certain
9	requirements for listing on registry; requiring promulgation of certain rules; and declaring an
10	emergency.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.10, as
14	amended by Section 12, Chapter 251, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2024,
15	Section 427.10), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 427.10. A. Only licensed Oklahoma allopathic,
17	osteopathic and podiatric physicians may provide a medical marijuana
18	recommendation for a medical marijuana patient license under the
19	Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act.
20	B. A physician who has not completed his or her first residency
21	shall not meet the definition of "physician" under this section and
22	any recommendation for a medical marijuana patient license shall not
23	be processed by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

1 C. No physician shall be subject to arrest, prosecution or penalty in any manner or denied any right or privilege under state, 2 municipal or county statute, ordinance or resolution, including 3 without limitation a civil penalty or disciplinary action by the 4 5 State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners or 6 by any other business, occupation or professional licensing board or 7 bureau, solely for providing a medical marijuana recommendation for 8 9 a patient or for monitoring, treating or prescribing scheduled 10 medication to patients who are medical marijuana licensees. The provisions of this subsection shall not prevent the relevant 11 12 professional licensing boards from sanctioning a physician for failing to properly evaluate the medical condition of a patient or 13 for otherwise violating the applicable physician-patient standard of 14 15 care.

D. A physician who recommends use of medical marijuana shall not be located at the same physical address as a licensed medical marijuana dispensary.

E. If the physician determines the continued use of medical marijuana by the patient no longer meets the requirements set forth in the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act, the physician shall notify the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority and the license shall be immediately voided without right to an individual proceeding.

1	F. The Authority shall create and maintain a registry of
2	recommending physicians. Beginning January 1, 2026, to be eligible
3	to provide a medical marijuana recommendation to a licensed patient,
4	a physician shall be registered with the Authority.
5	G. To be registered with the Authority, a physician shall
6	comply with the medical education and continuing medical education
7	requirements described in this section and shall meet all other
8	requirements established by law or rule for the recommending
9	physician's respective licensure board. The medical education
10	related to medical marijuana shall be completed prior to the
11	physician being listed on the registry and shall be completed
12	annually to remain on the registry.
13	H. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana
14	Authority shall promulgate rules to establish initial medical
15	education and continuing medical education requirements for
16	recommending physicians. The State Board of Medical Licensure and
17	Supervision, the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, and the Board
18	of Podiatric Medical Examiners may consult with the Executive
19	Director of the Authority to develop or identify a list of approved
20	medical education courses for recommending physicians.
21	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
23	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
24	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
