7	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; requiring that portions of certain
8	appropriated funds be used for certain purposes; providing for duties and compensation of
9	administrators and employees; authorizing payment of certain expenses; authorizing certain transfers;
10 11	requiring certain transfers; authorizing certain early transfer requests; authorizing the exemption of unanticipated federal funds from expenditure and
11	budgetary limitations; providing procedures; requiring certain budget procedures; and prohibiting
13	certain budget procedures.
14	
15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Health
17	Care Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of
18	the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Million
19	Thirty-one Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars
20	(\$100,031,677.00) shall be used for program growth and to replace
21	funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal matching
22	dollars.
23	SECTION 2. A. The duties and compensation of employees, not
24	otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law shall be set by the
 Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to:

Pay professional expenses of the Administrator of the
 Authority including dues, licenses, professional memberships, and
 continuing education classes conducted in this state; and

Pay professional expenses of any employee including dues,
licenses, professional memberships, continuing medical education
classes conducted in this state, and medical malpractice insurance
provided he or she is a full-time employee of the Authority in
accordance with subsection B of Section 5006 of Title 63 of the
Oklahoma Statutes and is utilizing those professional skills in the
performance of his or her job duties.

14 SECTION 3. In order to facilitate cash management of federal 15 grant receipts and disbursements, the Office of Management and 16 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies between the Oklahoma 17 Health Care Authority federal and revolving funds in amounts 18 requested by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

19 SECTION 4. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to 20 transfer funds from Fund 205 and Fund 270 to Fund 200 and Fund 340 21 to satisfy claims made to the Authority under the Supplemental 22 Hospital Offset Payment Program Act.

23 SECTION 5. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care
24 Authority may request that receipt and expenditure of unanticipated

federal funds awarded after July 1, 2025, be exempt from expenditure
 limitations and from budgetary limitations.

SECTION 6. A. The Director of the Office of Management and 3 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies appropriated from the 4 5 General Revenue Fund and the Health Care Enhancement Fund to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority disbursing funds in the amounts and 6 ratios requested by the Authority, except that the cumulative 7 amounts transferred shall not exceed the cumulative amounts of equal 8 9 monthly allotments of the appropriations from the General Revenue Fund and the Health Care Enhancement Fund. 10

Monies appropriated or collected for the fiscal year ending 11 Β. 12 June 30, 2026, may be transferred to these disbursing funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, to satisfy encumbrances and 13 obligations of such fiscal year; provided, that monies equal in 14 amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the 15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, to the disbursing fund for the 16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, to satisfy encumbrances and 17 obligations of such fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in 18 writing to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 19 Services. 20

C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall maintain records of
 the inter-year transfers.

23 SECTION 7. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care 24 Authority may request, through the Director of the Office of

1	Management and Enterprise Services, the early transfer by the
2	Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue
3	Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the agency's disbursing
