7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Water Resources  
8 Board; making appropriations; identifying sources of  
9 funds; stating purposes; providing an effective date;  
10 and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water  
14 Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
15 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State Treasury  
16 created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum  
17 of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for the purpose of providing  
18 water infrastructure funding to a rural water sewer and solid waste  
19 management district in the central region of the state experiencing  
20 private water well contamination from an unknown source and needing  
21 connected with a public water supply.

22 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water  
23 Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
24 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State Treasury

1 created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum  
2 of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for the purpose of  
3 constructing water lines in a county with a population greater than  
4 one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) and less than two hundred  
5 thousand (200,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census  
6 and located in a community not adjacent to a major roadway  
7 designated as an interstate.

8 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water  
9 Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
10 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State Treasury  
11 created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum  
12 of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for the purpose of  
13 establishing grant programs that facilitate the design,  
14 construction, and maintenance of water and wastewater  
15 infrastructure, and to improve the condition of publicly owned,  
16 deficient dams regulated by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board.

17 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

18 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
