7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
8 Commerce; requiring that portions of certain  
9 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes;  
10 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
11 emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
14 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st  
15 Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Five Hundred  
16 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to support the  
17 Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance Program.

18 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
19 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st  
20 Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred  
21 Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be used to provide support to  
22 an Oklahoma-based nonprofit in order to preserve sports heritage and  
23 pride in Oklahoma.

24 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st

1 Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred  
2 Ninety-eight Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$198,660.00) shall  
3 be used for community action agencies to support Head Start  
4 programs, and shall not be used for administrative expenses.

5 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

6 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
