6 An Act relating to income tax; amending 68 O.S. 2021,
7 Section 2368.16, which relates to donation from a tax
8 refund; reauthorizing donation of tax refund for the
9 benefit of a regional food bank; updating statutory
10 reference; providing an effective date; and declaring
11 an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 2368.16, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 2368.16. A. Each state individual income tax return
16 form for tax years which begin after December 31, 2007, and each
17 state corporate tax return form for tax years beginning after
18 December 31, 2007, shall contain a provision to allow a donation
19 from a tax refund for the benefit of any regional food bank in this
20 state. For purposes of this section, "regional food bank" means a
21 nonprofit charitable organization exempt from taxation pursuant to
22 the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, 26
23 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which as a part of a food bank network,
24 maintains a food distribution operation providing food to other
nonprofit entities that offer groceries or meals to people in need

1 of food assistance. The provision to allow donation shall read as
2 follows:

3 Support of programs for regional food banks in this state.

4 Check if you wish to donate from your tax refund: () \$2, () \$5,
5 or () \$ ____.

6 B. Except as otherwise provided for in this section, all monies
7 generated pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be paid to
8 the State Treasurer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and placed to the
9 credit of the Income Tax Checkoff Revolving Fund for Oklahoma
10 Regional Food Banks created in subsection C of this section.

11 C. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
12 fund for the Department of Human Services to be designated the
13 "Income Tax Checkoff Revolving Fund for Oklahoma Regional Food
14 Banks". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
15 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies apportioned to the
16 fund pursuant to the provisions of this section. All monies
17 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
18 be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services for the
19 purpose of providing funding for all regional food banks in this
20 state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
21 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
22 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
23 Services for approval and payment.

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1 D. If a taxpayer makes a donation pursuant to subsection A of
2 this section in error, such taxpayer may file a claim for refund at
3 any time within three (3) years from the due date of the tax return.
4 Such claims shall be filed pursuant to the provisions of Section
5 2373 of this title. Prior to the apportionment set forth in this
6 section, an amount equal to the total amount of refunds made
7 pursuant to this subsection during any one (1) year shall be
8 deducted from the total donations received pursuant to this section
9 during the following year and such amount deducted shall be paid to
10 the State Treasurer and placed to the credit of the Income Tax
11 Withholding Refund Account.

12 E. Pursuant to Section 2368.18 of this title, the income tax
13 checkoff contained in this section is hereby reauthorized effective
14 ~~January 1, 2019~~ January 1, 2026.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
