1 offer or contract specify, or the franchise seller promises or 2 represents, orally or in writing, that:

- a. the franchisee will obtain the right to operate a
 business that is identified or associated with the
 franchisor's trademark, or to offer, sell or
 distribute goods, services or commodities that are
 identified or associated with the franchisor's
 trademark,
- 9 b. the franchisor will exert or has authority to exert a
 10 significant degree of control over the franchisee's
 11 method of operation, or provide significant assistance
 12 in the franchisee's method of operation, and
- c. as a condition of obtaining or commencing operation of
 the franchise, the franchisee makes a required payment
 or commits to make a required payment to the
 franchisor or its affiliate.

B. A franchisor shall not be considered the employer of a
franchisee or a franchisee's employees.

C. The employees of a franchisee shall not be considered
employees of the franchisor; neither shall the employees of a
franchisor be considered employees of a franchisee.
