6 An Act relating to the Massage Therapy Practice Act;
7 amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 4200.10, which relates
8 to preemption; updating statutory language; providing
9 exceptions for certain preemption; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 4200.10, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 4200.10. A. The Massage Therapy Practice Act shall
15 supersede all ordinances or regulations regulating massage
16 therapists in any city, county, or political subdivision of this
17 state.

18 B. This section shall not affect the regulations of a city,
19 county, or a political subdivision of this state relating to zoning
20 requirements or occupational license fees pertaining to health care
21 professions.

22 C. This section shall not affect the regulations of a city,
23 county, or a political subdivision of this state relating to zoning

1 or licensing requirements for business locations offering massage
2 therapy.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
