An insurer shall furnish, upon written request of any insured claiming to have a loss under an insurance 14 contract issued by such insurer, forms of proof of loss for 15 completion by such person, but such insurer shall not, by reason of 16 the requirement so to furnish forms, have any responsibility for or 17 with reference to the completion of such proof or the manner of any 18 such completion or attempted completion. 19 It shall be the duty of the insurer, receiving a proof of 20 loss, to submit a written offer of settlement or rejection of the 21 claim to the insured within sixty (60) days of receipt of that proof 22 of loss. Upon a judgment rendered to either party, costs and 23

attorney fees shall be allowable to the prevailing party. For

1	purposes of this section, the prevailing party is the insurer in
2	those cases where judgment does not exceed written offer of
3	settlement. In all other judgments the insured shall be the
4	prevailing party. If the insured is the prevailing party, the court
5	in rendering judgment shall add interest on the verdict at the rate
6	of fifteen percent (15%) per year from the date the loss was payable
7	pursuant to the provisions of the contract to the date of the
8	verdict. This provision shall not apply to uninsured motorist
9	coverage or property insurance as defined in Section 704 of this
10	title.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
