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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
13	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
14	There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement
15	Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 30.6 of Title 74 of the
16	Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
17	the Opioid Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury,
18	the sum of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) to be budgeted
19	and expended in accordance with law.
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
21	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
22	There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement
23	Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 30.6 of Title 74 of the
24	Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from

1	the Opioid Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury,
2	the sum of One Million Two Hundred Fifty-three Thousand Six Hundred
3	Fifty-eight Dollars (\$1,253,658.00) to be distributed to non-
4	litigating subdivisions.
5	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
6	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
