8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
9 Commerce; making appropriations; identifying sources;  
10 establishing amounts; providing purposes; and  
11 providing for noncodification.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of  
17 Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
18 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to  
19 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Five  
20 Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be  
21 necessary to provide funding for a municipal park located in a  
22 county with a population greater than seven hundred fifty thousand  
23 (750,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census and north  
24 of I-344 and west of I-35.

1       SECTION 2.       NEW LAW       A new section of law not to be  
2       codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3       There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of  
4       Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
5       Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to  
6       Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Four  
7       Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be  
8       necessary to relocate a naval submarine located east of State  
9       Highway 165 and north of State Highway 62.

10       SECTION 3.       NEW LAW       A new section of law not to be  
11       codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

12       There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of  
13       Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
14       Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to  
15       Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of One  
16       Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00) or so much  
17       thereof as may be necessary to implement infrastructure improvements  
18       at an industrial park located south of State Highway 62 and east of  
19       State Highway 283.
