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14 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma has a health care shortage, in  
15 particular in the rural parts of the state; and

16 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma wants to support and protect the  
17 rural health care community and medical care provided in those  
18 areas; and

19 WHEREAS, the Physician Self-Referral Law or Stark Law, 42  
20 U.S.C., Section 1395nn, within the Social Security Act of the United  
21 States Code, is an impediment to the rural health care community and  
22 medical care.  
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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the State of Oklahoma be exempt from the provisions of the Stark Law, 42 U.S.C., Section 1395nn, which adversely impact the delivery of essential medical care in rural areas of the state.

THAT the State of Oklahoma be exempt from any administrative rule adopted pursuant to the authority of the Stark Law, 42 U.S.C., Section 1395nn, which adversely impacts the delivery of essential medical care in rural areas of the state.
