the American Midwest - always emphasizing faith, service, and moral

conviction; and

MHEREAS, from 1999 to 2001, Pope Leo XIV served on the Board of
Directors of Cascia Hall Preparatory School in Tulsa, Oklahoma,

contributing to the spiritual and academic life of a respected

institution in our state and leaving a legacy of guidance and

WHEREAS, Pope Leo XIV's election is not only a historic milestone for the Catholic Church, but a moment of great pride for all Americans, regardless of faith — a testament to the enduring influence of American values, religious freedom, and leadership on the global stage; and

WHEREAS, throughout his ministry, Pope Leo XIV has demonstrated a consistent commitment to the dignity of every human life, the importance of strong families, and a call to serve the least among us, values that resonate across faith traditions and reflect timeless truths shared by millions of Americans; and

WHEREAS, in a world marked by moral drift and cultural confusion, his election signals a voice of clarity, courage, and conviction in leadership, rooted not in political fashion, but in eternal principles.
