FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to constitutional conventions;
directing the Secretary of State to refer to the
people for their approval or rejection a proposed
amendment to the Constitution of the State of
Oklahoma by adding a new Section 4 to Article XXIV;
prohibiting consideration of proposals for
modifications to the Oklahoma Constitution outside
certain prescribed scope; providing ballot title; and
directing filing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
Oklahoma by adding a new Section 4 to Article XXIV thereof, to read
as follows:

The Legislature shall not take any action on a proposed
amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution if the action would be

1 outside the scope of the subject matter authorized to be considered
2 at the constitutional convention.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this act shall be in the
5 following form:

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It would add a new
10 Section 4 to Article 24. The question of whether to hold a
11 constitutional convention must be approved by a vote of the people.
12 Any proposed changes to the Oklahoma Constitution resulting from the
13 convention must be submitted to a vote of the people by the
14 Legislature. This provision would prohibit the Legislature from
15 taking any action on a measure that would submit any proposed change
16 to the Oklahoma Constitution for consideration by the people if the
17 proposed change was not related to a topic that was allowed to be
18 considered at the constitutional convention.

22 SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
23 immediately after the passage of this act, shall prepare and file

2 General.
