14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 106, O.S.L.
16	2024 (74 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 325.20), is amended to read as
17	follows:
18	Section 325.20. A. <del>In lieu of an automatic fire extinguishing</del>
19	system, portable fire extinguishers shall be installed in mobile
20	food establishments that produce All mobile food preparation
21	vehicles operating within this state prior to July 1, 2024, that are
22	capable of producing smoke or grease-laden vapors shall be in
23	compliance with the most current adopted fire code. With the
24	exception of an automatic fire extinguishing system, such

- 1 requirement shall apply to vehicles including, but not limited to,
- 2 | vehicles utilizing electric energy, liquefied petroleum gas,
- 3 | compressed natural gas, or a combination thereof for cooking,
- 4 provided that portable fire extinguishers are installed and
- 5 | maintained in accordance with the most current version of NFPA 10:
- 6 | Standard for Portable Fire Extinguishers. All fire extinguishers
- 7 | shall be inspected annually by a licensed contractor. A six-liter
- 8 | Class K-rated, portable fire extinguisher is required for all
- 9 cooking equipment involving solid fuels or, vegetable or animal oils
- 10 and fats, or a combination thereof. All portable fire extinguishers
- 11 | shall be in clear view and immediately available for use.
- 12 B. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force
- 13 and effect of law on November 1, 2025 All mobile food preparation
- 14 | vehicles utilizing, handling, or transporting liquefied petroleum
- 15 gas or any liquefied petroleum gas system, equipment, container,
- 16 apparatus, or appliance shall receive and maintain a permit from,
- 17 and be inspected annually by, the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas
- 18 | Administration or its employees, in conjunction with the State Fire
- 19 Marshal issuing an annual operation permit decal to mobile food
- 20 preparation vehicles.
- C. The provisions in subsection A of this section shall expire
- 22 on January 1, 2026, and all mobile food preparation vehicles shall
- 23 comply with the most current adopted fire codes set forth by this
- 24 state.

- D. Mobile food preparation vehicles shall be under the

  jurisdiction of the State Fire Marshal for fire and life safety code

  compliance and shall be inspected annually by the State Fire Marshal

  to ensure compliance with the latest version of the state-adopted

  minimum codes for fire and life safety as adopted by the Oklahoma

  Uniform Building Code Commission. The State Fire Marshal shall

  coordinate, at minimum, annual inspections conducted:
  - 1. Within each of the four quadrants of this state; and
  - 2. Twice within each county with a population exceeding four hundred thousand (400,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census.
  - E. Upon approval, the State Fire Marshal shall issue an operational permit decal indicating that the vehicle meets the minimum fire and life code requirements adopted at the time of inspection.
    - F. Nothing in this section shall prevent:
  - 1. The State Fire Marshal from enforcing the minimum fire code requirements as allowed by law and revoking the operations of a mobile food preparation vehicle for cause when such vehicle is determined to be inherently dangerous to the health, safety, or welfare of persons within this state;
  - 2. A political subdivision from enforcing the event permits, operational fees, land use regulations, zoning, or other ordinances

1 in relation to the operation of a mobile food preparation vehicle 2 within the boundaries of the political subdivision; or 3. The State Department of Health from licensing and regulating 3 4 mobile food preparation vehicles as provided by the provisions of 5 Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes and rules promulgated by the State 6 Commissioner of Health. 7 G. The State Fire Marshal may promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section. Such rules shall have 9 uniform force and effect throughout this state and no political subdivision or other agency shall enact or enforce any fire or life 10 safety code-related ordinances, rules, or other requirements for 11 mobile food preparation vehicles, except in a county with a 12 13 population exceeding four hundred thousand (400,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census. 14 SECTION 2.
