12           An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
13   Commerce; making appropriations; identifying sources;  
14   establishing amounts; providing purposes; providing  
for noncodification; providing an effective date; and  
declaring an emergency.

17   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law not to be  
19   codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20           There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of  
21   Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
22   Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to  
23   Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Five  
24   Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary to provide funding for a municipal park located in a  
2 county with a population greater than seven hundred fifty thousand  
3 (750,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census and north  
4 of I-344 and west of I-35.

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
6 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

7 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of  
8 Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
9 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to  
10 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Four  
11 Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be  
12 necessary to relocate a naval submarine located east of State  
13 Highway 165 and north of State Highway 62.

14 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of  
17 Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
18 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to  
19 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of One  
20 Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00) or so much  
21 thereof as may be necessary to implement infrastructure improvements  
22 at an industrial park located south of State Highway 62 and east of  
23 State Highway 283.

24 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
