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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 348, O.S.L.
20	2022 (62 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 2021), is amended to read as
21	follows:
22	Section 2021. A. There is hereby established a fund within the
23	State Treasury to be known as the Oklahoma Disaster Mitigation and
24	Recovery Matching Fund, to be administered by the Oklahoma

Department of Commerce. The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal year limitations. Within the Oklahoma Disaster Mitigation and Recovery Matching Fund there shall be established separate accounts as prescribed by Section 4 <u>2022</u> of this act <u>title</u> into which shall be deposited such funds as may be provided by law.

B. One of nine accounts shall be available to each entity
described in subsection A of Section 4 <u>2022</u> of this act <u>title</u>.

8 C. One account shall be divided equally into two subaccounts. 9 One of the two subaccounts shall be available to each of the 10 entities described by subsection B of Section 4 <u>2022</u> of this <del>act</del> 11 <u>title</u> for distribution to any city or town within the respective 12 jurisdiction of the entity or for the benefit of an unincorporated 13 area.

14 D. No funds deposited into one account or subaccount shall be 15 transferred to any other account The Oklahoma Department of Commerce 16 may deposit funds in any account or subaccount as needed, in any 17 amount, up to and including the full amount of the available funds 18 in order to pay for eligible activities at any time. The Oklahoma 19 Department of Commerce may exercise discretion to determine the 20 appropriate amount of funds needed to support eligible activities. 21 No entity may access any more than one account per fiscal year and 22 the total expenditure from any one account for each fiscal year may 23 not exceed the amount of funds available to each account as may be 24 provided by law.

1	E. No monies in the Oklahoma Disaster Mitigation and Recovery
2	Matching Fund shall be used for the payment of administrative
3	expenses, salaries, or any other continuing obligation of the
4	Oklahoma Department of Commerce.
5	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
