11 An Act relating to milk; amending 2 O.S. 2021,
12 Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and
13 Milk Products Acts; providing additional acts that
14 are not prohibited; removing gallon limit for
15 incidental sale of raw milk; and providing an
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 7-414. ~~A.~~ The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk
21 Products Act shall not be construed to:

22 1. Include ~~incidental~~ sales of raw, unpasteurized cow milk,
23 goat milk, or sheep milk directly to consumers ~~at:~~

24 a. at the farm where the milk is produced,

- 1 b. at feed stores; however, the container the milk is
2 being sold out of must be conspicuously labeled with
3 signage stating "Unpasteurized Milk",
4 c. at a farmer's market; however, the container the milk
5 is being sold out of must be conspicuously labeled
6 with signage stating "Unpasteurized Milk", or
7 d. via delivery from the farm where the milk is produced;

8 2. ~~Preclude~~ Prohibit the advertising of the ~~incidental~~ sale of
9 raw, unpasteurized cow milk, goat milk, or sheep milk; and or

10 3. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
11 milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

12 ~~B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk~~
13 ~~are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold~~
14 ~~does not exceed one hundred (100).~~

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
