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10                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11           An Act relating to veterans; imposing requirements on  
12           executive governmental entities to provide  
13           information related to certain donations; providing  
14           for apportionment or deposit of amounts donated;  
15           requiring government websites to provide information  
16           related to certain donations; providing for  
17           codification; providing an effective date; and  
18           declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
21           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7201 of Title 74, unless there  
22           is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23           A.   Each state agency, board, commission, department, or other  
24           entity organized within the executive department shall include on

1 any of its forms as described by subsection B of this section a link  
2 to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs or similar method in  
3 order to allow a person making payment to such governmental entity  
4 to make a donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs  
5 Revolving Fund.

6 B. The provisions of this section shall include, but shall not  
7 be limited to:

- 8 1. Driver license applications;
- 9 2. Motor vehicle registrations and renewals;
- 10 3. Fishing and hunting license applications;
- 11 4. Income tax forms; and
- 12 5. Any other transaction during which an executive agency

13 issues a license or utilizes a form that could contain the  
14 information prescribed by subsection A of this section.

15 C. If payment for any item or service described in this section  
16 can be made through a website owned or maintained on behalf of the  
17 governmental entity, the website shall have a conspicuous area which  
18 clearly indicates that the payor may utilize the website to make a  
19 donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs Revolving  
20 Fund.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
