

1 persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial
2 assistance as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year with a licensed operator.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service
9 Oklahoma or a licensed operator, unless authorized by Service
10 Oklahoma to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
11 Service Oklahoma shall notify by mail all persons issued special
12 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
13 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
14 presentation to a licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The
15 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

16 Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a
17 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept
18 applications for special license plates authorized under this
19 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's
20 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
21 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
22 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
23 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators
24 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for

1 registration of a motor vehicle through June 30, 2025. Through June
2 30, 2025, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications
3 and renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement
4 Fund. Beginning July 1, 2023, fees shall be retained by the
5 licensed operator pursuant to subsection E of Section 1141.1 of this
6 title.

7 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
8 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
9 2006, Service Oklahoma shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
10 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
11 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
12 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
13 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
14 removed from the vehicle.

15 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
16 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by Service
17 Oklahoma until Service Oklahoma receives one hundred prepaid
18 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
19 Service Oklahoma within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
20 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
21 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
22 not received by Service Oklahoma within such prescribed time period
23 any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

8 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to Service
10 Oklahoma by the Department of Environmental Quality in consultation
11 with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
12 demonstrate support to implement the statewide general public
13 Environmental Education Program created pursuant to the provisions
14 of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
16 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
17 plates. A dealer's license plate issued pursuant to Section 1116.1
18 or 1128 of this title may be designated an Environmental Awareness
19 License Plate upon payment of the fee imposed by this section and
20 any other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
21 and Registration Act. As provided in this section, an amount of the
22 fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104.2 of
23 this title;

1 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
3 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
4 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
5 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
6 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
11 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
13 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
14 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
15 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma State Firefighters Association.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
19 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma State Firefighters Museum
20 and the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

21 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to Service
23 Oklahoma by the Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation
24 with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in this state through
2 the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in Section 3-310 of Title
3 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may be designed and issued
4 to any person as for personalized license plates.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
7 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to Service
10 Oklahoma by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
11 Department of Health and the Child Abuse Prevention Action
12 Committee, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for the prevention of child abuse.

14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

16 6. United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee Supporter
17 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
18 person wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic
19 and Paralympic Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person
20 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
21 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
22 the official United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee logo.
23 Service Oklahoma shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
24 licensing agreement with the United States Olympic and Paralympic

1 Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
2 use the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee logo or
3 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
4 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
5 issued;

6 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
8 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
9 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
10 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

11 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

12 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
13 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
14 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
15 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
16 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
17 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Oklahoma Route
18 66 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

19 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. Service
21 Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
22 agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association,
23 Inc., for any licensing fees which may be required in
24 order to use the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc.,

1 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
2 for a payment to the Oklahoma Route 66 Association,
3 Inc., of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
4 each motorcycle license plate issued;

5 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
7 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
8 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
9 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
10 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
11 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
14 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
15 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
17 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Emergency Medical Technicians
19 Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
20 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
21 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
22 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
3 breast cancer in this state;

4 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Crime Victims
8 Compensation Program. As provided in this section, an amount of the
9 fee collected shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's
10 Revolving Fund for the Office of the Attorney General, which is
11 hereby directed to use such funds to contract with a statewide
12 nonprofit organization to provide services to crime victims;

13 13. Safe Kids Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support and
15 awareness of the Safe Kids Oklahoma. The license plate shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association.
17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 deposited in the Children's Hospital - Oklahoma Safe Kids
19 Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Safe Kids
20 Oklahoma program;

21 14. Oklahoma Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by
23 the Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support of the Oklahoma Four-H Club. Such plates may be

1 designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
2 plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
3 shall be apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate
4 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

5 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma,
7 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
9 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
10 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
11 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
12 1104.3 of this title;

13 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
15 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
16 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
17 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Department of Commerce Revolving Fund
20 created in Section 5012 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by
23 the State Department of Education in consultation with the Oklahoma
24 Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

1 support for education in this state. All licensed operators shall
2 display a sample of the Support Education License plate in the area
3 of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three Dollars
4 (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as follows:

5 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
6 Reform Revolving Fund,

7 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Oklahoma
8 State Regents for Higher Education Revolving Fund,

9 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
10 Career-Technology Fund, and

11 d. eighty-five percent (85%) shall be deposited to the
12 Retirement Benefit Fund as set forth in Section 17-108
13 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

14 However, when the Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy
15 percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as
16 required by law, the amount of the fee shall be apportioned equally
17 pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this paragraph;

18 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
19 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
20 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
21 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
22 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
23 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
24 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in

1 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
2 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
3 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
4 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
5 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
6 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
7 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
8 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
9 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
10 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
11 Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

12 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
15 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
16 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
17 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. Service
18 Oklahoma shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
19 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
20 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
21 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
22 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
23 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to
3 Service Oklahoma, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,
4 and Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this
5 state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry
6 and beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
8 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
9 of this title;

10 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service
12 Oklahoma by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
14 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
15 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
16 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
17 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

18 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
19 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
20 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
21 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
22 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
23 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
24 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the

1 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
2 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
3 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
4 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
5 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
6 created families;

7 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
8 subject to criteria presented to Service Oklahoma, by Choose Life
9 America, Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate
10 support of organizations that encourage adoption as a positive
11 choice for women with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this
12 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
13 Choose Life Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section
14 1104.6 of this title;

15 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
17 the Oklahoma FFA Association (formerly known as Future Farmers of
18 America). The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
19 the Oklahoma FFA Association Board of Directors. As provided in
20 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
21 provided in Section 1104.7 of this title;

22 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
23 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
24 Clubs of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any

1 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
2 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
3 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
4 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
5 of Lions Clubs. Service Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into
6 a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation.
7 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
8 Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for
9 each license plate issued;

10 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by
12 the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person wishing
13 to demonstrate support for preserving and planting wildflowers and
14 native plants in this state and to promote Oklahoma's wildflower
15 heritage through education. As provided in this section, an amount
16 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
17 1104.8 of this title;

18 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
19 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
20 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
21 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
22 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
23 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
24 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo.

1 Service Oklahoma shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
2 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
3 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
4 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
5 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Magic Empire
6 Council of Girl Scouts, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
7 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
8 plate issued;

9 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
12 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
13 Service Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
14 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
15 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
16 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
17 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
18 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

19 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed to demonstrate support for the Grand River Dam Authority.
21 The plates shall be designed in consultation with the Grand River
22 Dam Authority. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
23 apportioned to the Grand River Dam Authority;

24

1 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
3 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
4 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
5 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
6 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
7 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
8 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

9 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
12 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
14 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
15 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
16 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
18 Section 1104.10 of this title;

19 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma
21 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
22 residents who are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and
23 deployed on active duty. The plates shall be issued to any person
24 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of

1 seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided in this
2 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
3 Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of
4 this title;

5 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Military Department of the State
7 of Oklahoma and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
8 for Oklahoma residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the
9 United States or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the
10 Global War on Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in
11 any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
12 As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
13 deposited in the Oklahoma National Guard Museum Fund created in
14 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
16 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
18 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
19 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
20 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
21 Clubs of America logo. Service Oklahoma, if necessary, may enter
22 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
23 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
24 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing

1 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
2 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
3 plate issued;

4 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the American Quarter Horse in this state. The plate shall be
7 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
8 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
9 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
10 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

11 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
13 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
15 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
16 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
17 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
18 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
19 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

20 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
22 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. Service Oklahoma shall be
24 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma

1 Zoological Society for any licensing fee which may be required in
2 order to use the Oklahoma Zoological Society's logo or design. The
3 licensing agreement shall provide for payment to the Oklahoma
4 Zoological Society of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
5 license plate issued;

6 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
7 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
8 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
9 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
11 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
13 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

14 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
17 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
18 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
19 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
20 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. Service

22 not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

23 83. Cystic Fibrosis Foundation License Plate - such plates
24 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

1 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with the administration of the Cystic Fibrosis
3 Foundation. Service Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a
4 licensing agreement with the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation for any
5 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
6 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
7 for a payment to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation of not more than
8 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 84. Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
10 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for the Down Syndrome Association of Central
12 Oklahoma. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the
13 Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
14 collected shall be deposited in the Down Syndrome Association of

14 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 87. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of
17 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
18 personalized license plates, and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit
20 charitable organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the
21 provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section
22 501(c) (3), which provides emotional and financial support for downed
23 bikers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
24 the Central Oklahoma Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and

13 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
14 Foundation. Service Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a
15 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
16 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
17 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
18 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
19 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 93. Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed to honor the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign
22 Wars Chapters and shall be issued to any resident of this state upon
23 proof of membership in the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars
24 organization. The license plates shall be designed in consultation

1 with the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars organization. Service
2 Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
3 with the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars organization for any
4 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
5 organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall

18 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
19 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars
20 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

21 97. Greenwood Historical District License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
23 Tulsa Juneteenth Festival held in the Greenwood Historical District
24 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person for a

7 state. Service Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a

2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

4 consultation with the Epilepsy Foundation of Oklahoma. Service
5 Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into licensing agreements with
6 the Epilepsy Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required
7 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing

13 consultation with the Alliance of Mental Health Providers of
14 Oklahoma. Service Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into
15 licensing agreements with the Alliance of Mental Health Providers of
16 Oklahoma for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
17 use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
18 shall provide for a payment to the Alliance of Mental Health
19 Providers of Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for

1 meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. Service
2 Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
3 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Centennial Commission for any licensing
4 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66

8 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
9 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
10 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
11 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows through
12 June 30, 2023:

13 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
14 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
15 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
16 authorizing the special license plate;

17 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
18 be deposited in the Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for
19 the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration
20 Act. Beginning January 1, 2023, Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of
21 renewal of the fee shall be deposited in the Service Oklahoma
22 Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma
23 Vehicle License and Registration Act; and

24

1 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
2 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
