22 amounting to any burglary, enters any building or part of any
23 building, booth, tent, warehouse, railroad car, vessel, or other

1 structure or erection with intent to commit any felony, larceny, or
2 malicious mischief, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

3 B. Every person who, without the intention to commit any crime
4 therein, shall willfully and intentionally break and enter into any
5 building, trailer, vessel or other premises used as a dwelling
6 without the permission of the owner or occupant thereof, except in
7 the cases and manner allowed by law, shall be guilty of a
8 misdemeanor.

9 C. Every person who breaks into and enters the dwelling house
10 of another in which there is, at the time, some human being, without
11 the intention to commit any crime therein shall, upon conviction, be
12 guilty of breaking and entering into an occupied dwelling, a Class
13 C2 felony offense punishable by imprisonment as provided for in
14 subsections B through F of Section 20M of this title.

15 D. Every person who, with the intent to commit a crime, enters
16 an area of a commercial business that is:

17 1. Commonly reserved for personnel of the commercial business
18 where money or other property is kept; or

19 2. Clearly marked with a sign or signs that indicates to the
20 public that entry is forbidden,
21 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
22 imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than one (1)
23 year, or a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
24 by both such fine and imprisonment. Any second or subsequent

1 conviction under the provisions of this subsection shall be a felony
2 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of
3 Corrections for a term of not more than two (2) years, or by a fine
4 of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such
5 fine and imprisonment.

6 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
