21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 3242.2, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 3242.2. A. ~~Except as otherwise provided in Section~~
24 ~~3242 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, an An individual who is~~

1 not lawfully present in the United States shall not be eligible on
2 the basis of residence within the state for:

3 1. Any postsecondary education benefit, including, but not
4 limited to, scholarships or financial aid; or

5 2. Resident tuition.

6 ~~B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not~~
7 ~~apply to a student enrolled in a degree program at a postsecondary~~
8 ~~educational institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher~~
9 ~~Education during the 2006-2007 school year or any prior year who~~
10 ~~received a resident tuition benefit pursuant to Section 3242 of~~
11 ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes at that institution.~~

12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
