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11	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF
12	THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
13	At the next opportunity whereby Joint Rules of operation are
14	being considered for adoption by the Legislature the following Rule
15	Set shall be considered for adoption:
16	A. The Legislature hereby establishes the Legislative Division
17	of Administrative Code Review, which shall be tasked with reviewing
18	proposed administrative rules of state agencies. The Division shall
19	employ individuals as approved by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House
20	of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the State
21	Senate.
22	B. The Division is tasked with evaluating the following:
23	1. Whether proposed permanent administrative rules align with
24	the Oklahoma Constitution;

- 1 Whether proposed permanent rules fulfill the legislative intent of the statute that authorized the permanent rulemaking;
  - 3. Whether the proposed permanent rules will have a negative impact that is disproportionate to the intended effects of the rulemaking; and
  - Whether the agency has the statutory authority to promulgate the proposed permanent rules.
  - The Division shall issue a report including the information provided in subsection B of this section, a summary statement of the legislative recommendation being made, and any other information deemed necessary by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, and the Administrative Rules Committee Chairs of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the State Senate.
  - The Division may also be responsible for regular evaluations of existing provisions of the administrative code as directed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, and the Administrative Rules Committee Chairs of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the State Senate.

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
