1 sculpture, depicting a Celtic Trinity knot intertwined with a heart; and WHEREAS, in 2024, Oklahoma established Oklahoma Ireland Trade 3 4 Commission for Oklahoma business and industry to benefit from 5 Ireland's position with the European trade market; and 6 WHEREAS, many Oklahomans have Irish ancestry and continue to 7 celebrate that culture through festivals and celebrations, particularly in March, including the Tulsa Irish Fest, ShamROCK the 8 9 Gardens in Oklahoma City, and the Stockyards St. Patrick's Parade, 10 as well as other celebrations throughout the state; and WHEREAS, all Oklahomans are Irish on March 17, St. Patrick's 11 12 Day, honoring the Patron Saint of Ireland and celebrating Irish 1.3 heritage; and 14 WHEREAS, Oklahoma joins other states throughout the country in 15 celebrating diplomatic relations between Ireland and the United 16 States, which officially began on October 7, 1924. 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 18 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 19 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes the 20 state's long history of friendship and diplomatic relationships with 21 Ireland. 22 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives commemorates March 17 23 as St. Patrick's Day.
