9	A Resolution recognizing May 11 through May 17, 2025,
10	as National Police Week and recognizing May 15, 2025, as Peace Officers Memorial Day in the State of
11	Oklahoma.

13	WHEREAS, across the United States, the week of May 11 through
14	May 17, 2025, is being recognized as "National Police Week"; and
15	WHEREAS, on October 1, 1962, the United States Congress approved
16	a joint resolution authorizing the President of the United States to
17	designate May 15 of each year as "Peace Officers Memorial Day" in
18	honor of law enforcement officers who have been killed, disabled, or
19	otherwise injured in the line of duty and the calendar week during
20	which May 15 occurs as "National Police Week"; and
21	WHEREAS, by proclamation dated May 4, 1963, President John F.
22	Kennedy designated May 15, 1963, and each succeeding May 15 as
23	"Peace Officers Memorial Day" and the week of May 12 through May 18,

1 1963, and each succeeding calendar week during which May 15 occurs 2 as "National Police Week"; and

3 WHEREAS, federal, state, local, and tribal police officers,
4 sheriffs, and other law enforcement officers in the State of
5 Oklahoma and across the United States serve with valor, dignity, and
6 integrity; and

7 WHEREAS, law enforcement officers are charged with pursuing 8 justice for all individuals and performing the duties of a law 9 enforcement officer with fidelity to the constitutional rights of 10 the public that the law enforcement officers serve; and

11 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives expresses strong 12 support for law enforcement officers in Oklahoma and across the 13 United States in the efforts that those officers undertake to build 14 safer and more secure communities; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes the law enforcement community for the continual selfless acts of sacrifice and bravery carried out by the members of that community; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers swear an oath to uphold the public trust with their lives, if need be, even though, through the performance of the duties of a law enforcement officer, the officers may become targets for senseless acts of violence; and WHEREAS, within the last year, numerous law enforcement officers

24 from across the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice; and

1 WHEREAS, two Oklahoma law enforcement officers died in the line 2 of duty within the last year, Corporal Robert William Sumner of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections and Brian Keith Herbert of the 3 4 Osage Nation Police Department; and 5 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives honors the memory 6 of the hundreds of law enforcement officers who have given their 7 lives in the line of duty in this state and throughout the United 8 States. 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 10 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 11 THAT May 11 through May 17, 2025, is hereby recognized by the 12 Oklahoma House of Representatives as "National Police Week" and 13 recognizes May 15, 2025, as "Peace Officers Memorial Day" in 14 Oklahoma. 15 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives expresses condolences to the loved ones of each law enforcement officer who has made the 16 17 ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty. 18 19 DIRECT TO CALENDAR. 20 21 22 23 24
