SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Eighteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$18,500,000.00) shall be used for the continuum of care for

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00) shall be used to maintain services for veterans and their families.

SECTION 5. The Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance

Abuse Services may request through the Director of the Office of

Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the

Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue

Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's
