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10	An Act relating to forcible entry and detainer; amending 12 O.S. 2021, Sections 1148.4, 1148.5,
11	1148.5A, and 1148.16, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 184, O.S.L. 2023 (12 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section
12	1148.16), which relate to summons; extending time period for certain appearance; providing exceptions;
13	making language gender neutral; increasing time period for service of certain summons; providing
14	exceptions; conforming time periods for certain notice and hearing; providing exceptions; updating
15	statutory language; and providing an effective date.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2021, Section 1148.4, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	Section 1148.4. The summons shall be issued and returned as in
22	other cases, except that it shall command the sheriff, or other
23	person serving it, to summon the defendant to appear for trial at
24	the time and place specified therein, which time shall be not less

1 than five (5) days nor more than ten (10) days nor more than fifteen 2 (15) days from the date that the summons is issued; provided, however, a trial for an action pursuant to subsection C or D of 3 Section 132 of Title 41 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be not less 4 5 than five (5) days nor more than ten (10) days from the date the 6 summons is issued. The summons shall apprise the defendant of the nature of the claim that is being asserted against him; and there 7 shall be endorsed upon the summons the relief sought and the amount 8 9 for which the plaintiff will take judgment if the defendant fails to 10 appear. In all cases, pleadings may be amended to conform to the evidence. 11

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2021, Section 1148.5, is 13 amended to read as follows:

Section 1148.5. The summons may be served as in other cases 14 except that such service shall be at least three (3) seven (7) days 15 before the day of trial, and the return day shall not be later than 16 17 the day of trial, and it may also be served by leaving a copy thereof with some person over fifteen (15) years of age, residing on 18 the premises, at least three (3) seven (7) days before the day of 19 trial; or, if service cannot be made by the exercise of reasonable 20 diligence on the tenant or on any person over the age of fifteen 21 (15) years residing on the premises, the same may be served by 22 certified mail with return receipt postmarked at least three (3) 23 24 seven (7) days before the date of trial. Provided, service of a

1 <u>summons for an action pursuant to subsection C or D of Section 132</u>
2 <u>of Title 41 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be at least three (3)</u>
3 days before the date of trial.

4 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2021, Section 1148.5A, is 5 amended to read as follows:

Section 1148.5A. If, in the exercise of reasonable diligence, 6 service cannot be made upon the defendant personally nor upon any 7 person residing upon the premises over fifteen (15) years of age, 8 9 then in lieu of service by certified mail, service may be obtained 10 for the sole purpose of adjudicating the right to restitution of the premises by the sheriff's posting or by private process service 11 12 posting of said the summons conspicuously on the building on the premises, and, if there be is no building on said the premises, then 13 by posting the same at some conspicuous place on the premises sought 14 15 to be recovered at least five (5) seven (7) days prior to the date of trial, and by the claimant's mailing a copy of said the summons 16 to the last-known address of the defendant by certified mail at 17 least five (5) seven (7) days prior to said the date of trial; 18 provided, however, such service for an action pursuant to subsection 19 20 C or D of Section 132 of Title 41 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be posted at least five (5) days prior to the date of trial. 21 Such service shall confer no jurisdiction upon the court to render any 22 judgment against the defendant for the payment of money nor for any 23 relief other than the restoration of possession of the premises to 24

1 the claimant, unless the defendant appears at trial. If the court 2 only renders a judgment for restoration of possession of the 3 premises, the claimant shall not be precluded from pursuing a subsequent action for the payment of rent. A judgment for forcible 4 5 entry and detainer shall not preclude the property owner from pursuing a subsequent action for other monetary relief. 6 Such service shall not be rendered ineffectual by the failure of the 7 defendant to actually see or receive such posted process nor by the 8 9 failure of the defendant to actually receive or sign a return 10 receipt for such mailed process.

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 Section 1148.16), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1148.16. The summons to be issued in an action for 14 forcible entry and detainer, commonly known as an eviction, shall be 15 in a form developed in plain and understandable language by the 16 17 Oklahoma Bar Association. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall provide public access to the affidavit by providing a link to 18 the form on the Oklahoma State Courts Network (OSCN) website. 19 The summons shall be delivered no less than three (3) seven (7) days 20 before the scheduled time and date of the court hearing; provided, 21 however, a summons for an action pursuant to subsection C or D of 22 Section 132 of Title 41 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be delivered 23 24 no less than three (3) days before the date of trial. This

1	scheduled date and time shall not be less than $five$ (5) ten (10)
2	days <u>nor more than fifteen (15) days</u> from the date the summons is
3	issued; provided, however, the scheduled date and time for an action
4	pursuant to subsection C or D of Section 132 of Title 41 of the
5	Oklahoma Statutes shall not be less than five (5) days nor more than
6	ten (10) days from the date the summons is issued.
7	SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
