9	An Act relating to wildlife; amending 29 O.S. 2021, Section 7-304, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 19,
10	O.S.L. 2022 (29 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 7-304), which relates to wildlife refuges and Wildlife
11	Management Areas; requiring nonresident hunters to receive permission from the Oklahoma Wildlife
12	Conservation Commission to use certain areas; authorizing the Commission to create certain system
13	for permitting; requiring permit fee; providing for promulgation of rules; updating statutory language;
14	and providing an effective date.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 7-304, as
19	amended by Section 1, Chapter 19, O.S.L. 2022 (29 O.S. Supp. 2024,
20	Section 7-304), is amended to read as follows:
21	Section 7-304. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, no
22	person may enter upon any state or federal wildlife refuge or
23	Wildlife Management Area with <u>a</u> dog, <u>a</u> gun <u>,</u> or <u>a</u> bow.
24	

B. Exceptions to the above provisions are when the Oklahoma
 Wildlife Conservation Commission and/or the Oklahoma Tourism and
 Recreation Commission may by resolution permit:

The holding of field trials by duly authorized sportsmen's
 clubs; or

Such hunting, killing, or trapping of wildlife from such
refuge or Wildlife Management Area; provided, however, that Lake
Murray State Park shall not be utilized for <u>the</u> killing or trapping
of natural wildlife and shall remain a wildlife preserve.

10 C. <u>1. Upon authorization for the hunting, killing, or trapping</u> 11 <u>of wildlife from any such refuge or Wildlife Management Area by the</u> 12 <u>Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission pursuant to subsection B</u> 13 <u>of this section, the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall</u> 14 <u>require nonresidents to schedule with the Department of Wildlife</u> 15 <u>Conservation in order to receive written authorization to use such</u> 16 refuge or Wildlife Management Area.

17 <u>2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall create a</u>
 18 <u>lottery system as needed for the distribution of permits authorizing</u>
 19 <u>nonresidents to hunt, kill, or trap wildlife from such refuge or</u>
 20 <u>Wildlife Management Area and shall charge a permit fee not to exceed</u>
 21 <u>One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).</u>
 22 3. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall

23 promulgate any rules necessary to implement the provisions of this

24 section.

1	D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
2	section shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred
3	Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or
4	by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than ten (10) days
5	nor more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and
6	imprisonment for the first violation. A subsequent violation shall
7	result in the suspension of privileges to hunt, kill, or trap within
8	such refuge or Wildlife Management Area.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
