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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 52 of Title 74, unless there is
17	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. For purposes of this section:
19	1. "Biotechnology company of concern" means an entity
20	designated by the federal government to be under the control of a
21	foreign adversary and that poses a risk to national security based
22	on the company's research of multiomic data collection; and
23	2. "Multiomics" means a biological analysis method that

combines data from multiple research areas, including, but not

1	limited to, genomics, transcriptomics, proteomics, epigenomics, and
2	metabolomics in order to gain a comprehensive understanding of
3	complex biological processes.
4	B. Any state agency that receives federal or state funds shall
5	not be authorized to use or procure any biotechnology equipment or
6	service that originates from a company designated by the federal
7	government to be a biotechnology company of concern nor shall any
8	such state agency contract with an entity that uses or procures such
9	biotechnology.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the enactment of a
11	federal law that prohibits entities that receive federal funds from
12	using biotechnology that is from a company associated with a foreign
13	adversary.
