NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 180.91 of Title 19, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 The board of county commissioners may develop a policy in 18 accordance with the secretary of the county election board to 19 authorize county employees to receive up to three (3) working days' 20 paid administrative leave per calendar year for the purpose of 21 serving as a precinct official pursuant to Section 2-124 of Title 26 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, absentee voting board member pursuant to 23 Section 14-115.5 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or other 24

2	serve in such position.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
