15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2803.3 of Title 12, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A statement that purports to narrate, describe, report, or
20	explain an incident or incidents of domestic abuse as defined in
21	Section 60.1 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
22	1. Made by the victim of domestic abuse to a law enforcement
23	officer within one (1) week of the incident;

1	2. On an application for a protective order by the victim of
2	domestic abuse within one (1) week of the incident; or
3	3. Given as testimony of the victim of domestic abuse made at a
4	hearing on application for a protective order,
5	shall be admissible in pre-trial or post-trial criminal and juvenile
6	delinquent domestic abuse prosecutions including preliminary
7	hearings, prosecutive merit hearings, or hearings on the revocation
8	of probation or acceleration of a deferred judgment.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
