13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.9, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 2-101.9. Members of the State Election Board shall be
17	paid Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) <u>Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00)</u> per diem
18	for each meeting for the purpose of conducting hearings required by
19	law, and Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) <u>Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00)</u>
20	per diem for other meetings, and shall be allowed mileage
21	reimbursement at the rate provided by the State Travel Reimbursement
22	Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
23	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-115, is
24	amended to read as follows:

1	Section 2-115. The chair and vice-chair of each county election
2	board shall be paid Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) <u>Seventy-five</u>
3	Dollars (\$75.00) per diem in lieu of subsistence for each meeting of
4	the county election board and shall be allowed mileage reimbursement
5	at the rate prescribed for travel by state employees. The per diem
6	and mileage reimbursement shall be paid by the State Election Board,
7	except for meetings chargeable to other governmental units as
8	provided by law; provided, the State Election Board shall not pay
9	such reimbursement for more than forty meetings per fiscal year.
10	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
