15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 856.3, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 856.3. Any person who attempts or commits a gang-
19	related offense as a condition of membership in a criminal street
20	gang or while in association with any criminal street gang or gang
21	member shall be guilty of a felony offense. Upon punishable upon
22	conviction, the violator shall be punished by incarceration
23	<u>imprisonment</u> in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a
24	term of five (5) years, which shall be in addition to any other

1	penalty imposed. For purposes of this section, "criminal street
2	gang" is defined by subsection F of Section 856 of Title 21 of the
3	Oklahoma Statutes this title and "gang-related offense" means those
4	offenses enumerated in paragraphs 1 through 16 of subsection F of
5	Section 856 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
