NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-107b of Title 43A, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 A custodial parent under a court order entered pursuant to the 17 provisions of Title 43 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall receive notice 18 from the noncustodial parent, or the noncustodial parent's 19 representative if such parent is unable, if the noncustodial parent 20 is unable to comply with court-ordered visitation or any other 21 court-ordered requirement because he or she is receiving in-patient 22 treatment at a facility within the Department of Mental Health and 23 Substance Abuse Services or a facility certified by the Department.
