An Act relating to discrimination; adopting certain definition of anti-Semitism; stating purposes for use of certain definition; construing provisions; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1911 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State of Oklahoma hereby adopts the non-legally binding Working Definition of Anti-Semitism adopted by the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) on May 26, 2016, including the contemporary examples of anti-Semitism set forth therein, exclusively as a tool and guide for training, education, and

1 recognizing and combating anti-Semitic hate crimes or discrimination
2 and for tracking and reporting anti-Semitic incidents in this state.

3 B. The provisions of this act shall not be construed to
4 diminish or infringe upon any right protected under the First
5 Amendment to the United States Constitution or the Oklahoma
6 Constitution.
