9 A Concurrent Resolution recognizing National Lineman
10 Appreciation Day; praising lineworkers from Oklahoma
11 electric providers; and celebrating their work to
12 power homes and businesses across the state.

13 WHEREAS, as the true heroes of the electric power industry,
14 lineworkers are responsible for maintaining and repairing electrical
15 power grids 24 hours a day, 365 days a year; and

16 WHEREAS, these dedicated professionals are often the first to
17 respond during storms and other catastrophic weather events so other
18 first responders can get to the scene safely; and

19 WHEREAS, lineworkers operate under dangerous conditions and risk
20 their lives high atop power lines to keep electricity flowing; and

21 WHEREAS, lineworkers also play a vital role in Oklahoma's
22 economy by maintaining the energy infrastructure that powers homes
23 and businesses; and

1 WHEREAS, lineworkers deserve recognition for their hard work to
2 power local communities and keep people safe during emergencies.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
4 OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5 CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature recognizes April 18, 2025, as
7 National Lineman Appreciation Day.

8 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature extends its gratitude to
9 lineworkers from Public Service Company of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Gas
10 and Electric Company, Oklahoma Municipal Power Authority, the Grand
11 River Dam Authority, local electric cooperatives, and all other
12 electric providers for their dedicated service and swift action to
13 restore power in emergency situations.

14 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature commends lineworkers for their
15 vital role in powering homes and businesses throughout the state.

16 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature honors lineworkers for their
17 critical service in all types of weather, recognizing them as
18 essential first responders who risk their lives to ensure the safety
